

Enforcement Rules of NCTU Academic Achievement Award

1. NCTU defines the Enforcement Rules in order to encourage students with excellent academic and conduct achievements to urge the students to develop good morals and study harder.
2. Qualification and number of the awarded:
 - (1) Department:

With academic achievement at 80 grades above and conduct grades at 80 above, and ranking within 5% of the number of students in the class (carried without conditions), in the previous semester;
 - (2) Institute (master degree program):

1st grade institute students with excellent academic achievement and conduct grades more than 80 in the previous semester, and recommended by the institute dean; one to be awarded if the graduated students of the same grade of the same institute are less than 10 persons, and one additional vacancy shall be offered per 10 students if the students exceed 10 persons, and one additional vacancy shall also be offered if the students exceed 6 persons but less than 10 persons.
3. Contents of award:
 - (1) Department:

Those awarded will be conferred one certificate of merit and prize money ranging from NT\$3,000 to NT\$10,000. The exact amount shall be determined based on the annual budget.
 - (2) Institute (master degree program):

The awarded will be conferred one certificate of merit.
4. Semesters for award:
 - (1) Department:

From 1st semester of freshmen to 1st semester of seniors, totaling 7 semesters
 - (2) Institute (master degree program):

1st and 2nd semester of 1st grade institute students, totaling two semesters
5. The Academic Achievement Award shall be conferred once per semester. Registrar Division shall submit the name list of qualified students for review and approval at the beginning of the semester, and the award shall be conferred and promulgated at the weekly meeting upon approval.
6. The Enforcement Rules shall be enforced upon resolution of the Administrative Meeting. The same shall apply where the Enforcement Rules are amended.
